Activities and Testimonials

Mission Amsterdam – Supporting the Homeless

- Twice a month, we visit Amsterdam Central with volunteers to serve the homeless and those in need. Our approach varies with the season:
- From January to March 2025, we provided vital support including food, drinks, clothing, hygiene products, and school supplies.
- From March to June 2025, we distributed backpacks filled with seasonal essentials, ensuring people had what they needed for daily comfort and dignity during the transitional months.

These missions are not just about material support they are about connection. Each visit offers us the opportunity to sit, talk, and listen to those society often overlooks.

Together with brother Christian, I walk through the city center, where we speak with the poor and the needy. Their stories are powerful, and the moments we share are meaningful.

Mission Suriname – Kindertehuis Campagne

My visit to Suriname marked a deeply personal and touching moment in our mission work. I was excited to go to the children’s home, Kindertehuis Campagne, for the very first time. After a warm phone call confirming I was welcome during the day, I prepared supplies and donations for the children.

Upon arrival, I was greeted kindly by a staff member who received the items and generously shared stories about the children and the home itself. Listening to her and being with the children made a lasting impression. The time I spent there was more than a visit it was a heartfelt connection, filled with joy, reflection, and purpose.

In mid-2024, we officially adopted a family in Suriname—a grandmother, mother, and grandchildren—whom we support on a regular basis. Through continued care and connection, we aim to uplift their daily life.

Clothing Missions

Another important part of our work is the distribution of clothing. In the first half of the year, we sent:

- 4 boxes of clothing to Suriname, which were distributed to children and families in need
- 1 box of clothing to Ghana, reaching vulnerable communities with dignity and support

Each item donated serves not only a practical purpose but also conveys the message that someone cares.

Seasonal Projects

Our outreach is tailored to the seasons:

- January–March 2025: Food, drinks, clothing, hygiene products, and school supplies
- March–June 2025: Distribution of backpacks with seasonal essentials

We also plan to adopt a family in the Netherlands to provide local, ongoing support.

Our missions are led by Audrey Heinze, a dedicated volunteer who coordinates all outreach activities. With compassion and perseverance, she works alongside a team of volunteers who are equally committed to making a difference.
